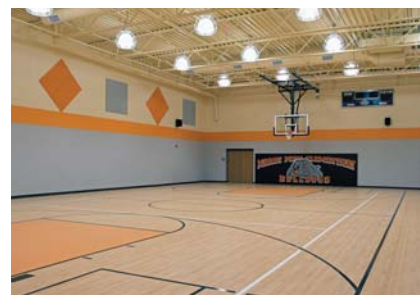
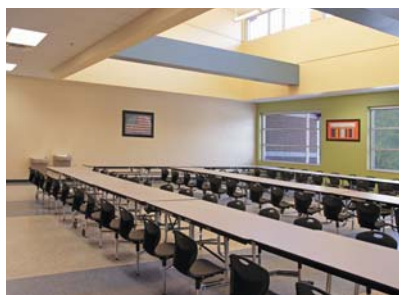

Located along the Coal River in rural Raleigh County, Marsh Fork Elementary is a replacement PK-5 facility for 225 students. Due to the small, steeply sloping site, the building is a very compact and efficient two-story design. Grades PK-2 are on the first floor, while grades 3-5 are located on the upper floor. Beyond traditional classrooms, the school also includes a dining room, kitchen, media center, computer lab, a spectator gymnasium, and administrative offices. In keeping with the rural flavor of the community, Marsh Fork Elementary's exterior design also includes a large 'front porch' at the main entry.
